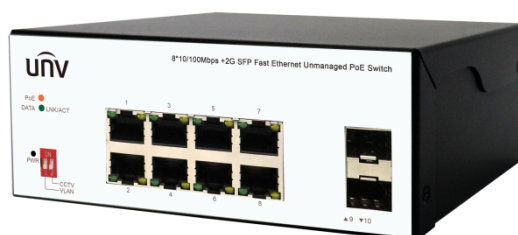

Features

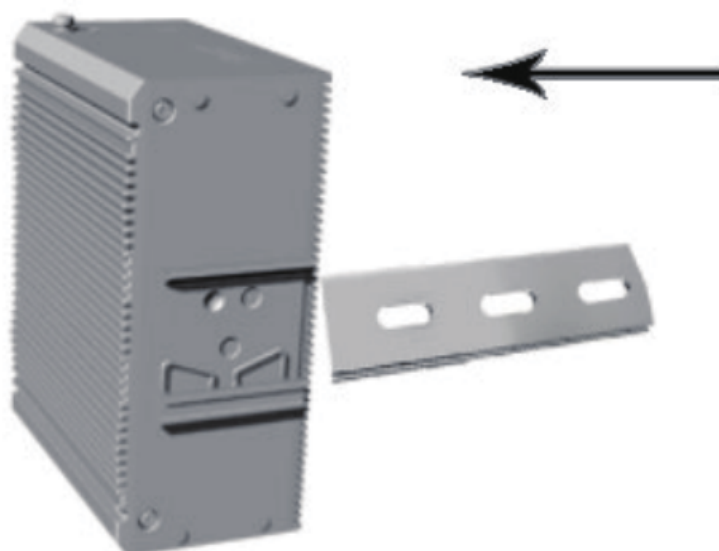
- PoE supports IEEE 802.3af/at standards and provides a maximum output of 30W for each port.
